 - Save course outlines and syllabi

History Honours and Honours with IR

- Check your Degree Navigator to make sure all your requirements are being completed
- See one of the advisors if your program does not look right on Degree Navigator
- If you take HIST 403, 466, or 468 for your HIST490 requirement, check whether it counts.
- If you are History Honours with IR:
 - You must take an IR seminar (not HIST490)
 - You do not have to meet the pre-modern requirement

Planning to Graduate in 2021?

- Apply for May graduation **before** February XX at Student Service Centre
 - students.ubc.ca/enrolement/graduation/applying-graduate
 - Applications open for Spring graduation on December xXth
 - Applications for November graduation closed on September 11th
- Do your “grad check” on Degree Navigator



Graduating with a History Minor?

- At least 30 and no more than 42 credits in History
 - At least 6 credits must be 200-level History
 - At least 18 must be numbered 300 or above
 - A maximum of 6 credits for non-HIST courses listed as acceptable for history credit.
 - A maximum of **6 eligible upper-level credits** may be double counted for both Major and Minor programs
-
- Department permission is not required to undertake a minor in History
 - Make sure Degree Navigator counts your credits correctly

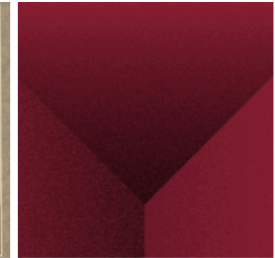
